MAS provides reliable access to individualized acupuncture-based care since 2007, and is the only 501(c)3 non-profit acupuncture provider in NH.

Why Is MAS A Non-Profit?

We view access to acupuncture like we do access to local utilities; the more the merrier. Simply put, we aim for more people to be able to make use of acupuncture more often. This is why we charge on a low sliding-scale with no income verification.

In order for this mission to be reached year after year, the enterprise has to rely on a collective approach to management and leadership - not a single owner. We prefer to think long-term when it comes to our patient's access to treatments.

The goal is to make treatments available as widely and as often as possible - for as long as possible - not to maximize profits.


